Admissions Policies

- Payment of tuition is part or in full is a commitment to enroll your child for the academic year and SMS will in turn, hold a place for your child.
- Accounts in arrears greater than **30 days** will result in the student's dismissal until such time as the account is cleared.
- SMS does not have the resources to support students whose behaviour is consistently aggressive or may pose a risk to themselves or others. SMS will determine, at its sole discretion, if a child will be able to continue at the school if such behaviour is present.
- Tuition will not be refunded in part or in full.
- Adjustments in tuition cannot be made if a student is absent for prolonged periods of time or if they are withdrawn from the school, for whatever reason. As a small school, SMS plans for the year based on revenue from tuition only. Providing refunds directly compromises our ability to run our programs.
- Fees are not subject to adjustment if distance learning becomes necessary for safety concerns or other government/Public Health directives. The costs of running the school do not change whether we are in person or on-line. Offering refunds will directly and negatively impact our ability to continue providing programs for our community.
- Attendance for and participation in asynchronous and synchronous learning opportunities, in person or as part of distance learning, are mandatory.
